

2009 ULMSTEAD DOCK RULES

The rules are few. Their purpose is to insure that your nautical facilities are safe, enjoyable and legal.

1. Docks are for recreational use by UCI members only. Commercial use (Chartering) of boats is expressly prohibited by UCI Bylaws (Article V, paragraph 8f).
2. Guests (see definition in UCI By-laws Section 2) must be accompanied by a qualified Resident member of Ulmstead Club. Members shall always be responsible for the actions of their guests.
3. No swimming or diving in the dock areas.
4. Do moor your boat securely in your assigned slip using Nylon (No Polypropylene or Dacron) dock lines of sufficient size (½" minimum). Keep it safe and don't let it be a hazard to others.
5. Do crab or fish anywhere except between someone else's boat and the dock. Clean up crabbing or fishing lines prior to leaving the dock. Do not tie crabbing or fishing lines to the fresh water plumbing or fire standpipe plumbing systems.
6. Stay off other people's boat unless invited.
7. Don't discharge waste or oil overboard.
8. MOTORCYCLES, BICYCLES, ROLLER BLADES, SKATE BOARDS, or ROLLER SKATES are not permitted on the dock.
9. All dogs must be leashed; if the party at either end of the leash creates a hazard, the party at the other end must clean it up.
10. No charcoal or open fires are permitted on docks or boats at dock.
11. Observe a safe speed with no wake in the dock areas.
12. Due to limited space and for safety reasons the construction/installation of dock boxes, catwalks or gangplanks is prohibited.
13. Noise levels shall be kept to a minimum at all times.
14. Caution shall be exercised at all times to ensure the safety of children, pedestrians, property and other boats
